Councilmember White Appeals UMC Board Decision on Obstetrics Unit Closure

(WASHINGTON, D. C.) – Ward 8 Councilmember Trayon White released the following statement after the public roundtable on United Medical Center held on January 16, 2018:

"I am deeply disappointed that United Medical Center Board Chair LaRuby May did not attend at the UMC Board roundtable on its decision to permanently close the obstetrics unit. As well, May has previously refused to provide the Committee with critical information regarding the events surrounding the decision to close the UMC obstetrics unit. With obstetrical services terminating at United Medical Center and at Providence Hospital, Ward 8 residents are experiencing a critical health care crisis. This is unacceptable and I will work unceasingly until every District resident East of the River has access to reliable, first-rate, and comprehensive health care."
