Councilmember White Hosts a Community Conversation on Ballou SHS

(Washington, D.C., February 9, 2018) — Councilmember Trayon White today announced that he will host a Community Conversation on the 'State of Ballou' on Tuesday, February 13, 2018 at Ballou Senior High School Auditorium.

The discussion will address the recent events and concerns around the Ballou High School investigations. Guest speakers will include DCPS Chancellor Antwan Wilson and other city officials, who will convene to address D.C. Public School policies and provide answers to improving the present conditions of Ballou SHS, and the future of public school protocols citywide.

"There is a need to provide our residents with answers to circumstances surrounding Ballou policies, protocols and recent allegations. During the discussion, we will address a variety of topics including updates on the new Alvarez & Marshal Report on DCPS Graduation and Attendance Outcomes, the Joevon Smith-Patterson incident, PTSA community involvement, and future programs and services," said Councilmember White.

All Ward 8 residents and Washington D.C. area community members are invited to attend. Doors to the event will open at 6:45pm and the program will begin at 7:15pm.


